Holy Father, **keep** them in **your name**, which you have **given** me, that they may be one, even as we are one. While I was with them, I **kept** them in your name, which you have given me. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **Sanctify** them in the truth; your word is **truth**. As you sent me into the world, so I have **sent** them into the world. And for their **sake** I **consecrate** myself, that they **also** may be **sanctified** in truth.




Jesus prayed for his followers.
